What is the European Master in Social Work?

The European Master in Social Work is a 2 year study programme in 6 countries in Europe leading up to a Master in Social Work.

In this study programme courses are offered from a European perspective on social inclusion and combating poverty. There are modules offered on various welfare systems and different approaches to Social Work in different parts of Europe.

When?

The Master Course starts every year in September in Groningen, the Netherlands.

The Master is accredited in the Netherlands since May 2012.
