We welcome 50 international students together with our hosting students, and about 10 teachers for lectures and workshops.

The fee will be 165 €. For students 5 nights in Hostel (Sunday – Friday), breakfast and lunch every day and two dinners are included.

Our International University Week will include lectures and workshops, field visits and culture and social activities.

The main goal for the IUW 2015 in Norway is to let students interact with students and give them an opportunity to share their experiences as students in social work. To achieve this we ask every University College to bring a case/an issue with challenges from daily life in social work. These cases/issues will be the basis for workshops with students and teachers from different countries, with the purpose of illuminating the cases from different perspectives and generate new solutions.
